## ***FINANCIAL, INSURANCE AND FUNDING INFORMATION***

### **INSURANCE INFORMATION:**

If you wish to use medical insurance, important information regarding your mental health benefits are available directly from your insurance provider. When completing the initial intake, we gather insurance information for billing purposes only (i.e., AFC cannot quote benefits for you). Confirmation of benefits is your responsibility and if AFC is unfamiliar with the benefit plan, you will pay full fee. Once coverage is confirmed, any credit accrued will be applied to future services or refunded.

When contacting your insurance provider regarding coverage, state that you are calling about **Outpatient Behavioral/Mental Health Benefits**. Here are some questions to help determine your benefit level:

- Is AFC/my AFC provider considered in-network or out-of-network for my plan?
- What are my in-network and out-of-network annual deductible amounts?
- Is my behavioral/mental health deductible part of or separate from my medical deductible?
- How much of the deductible has been met?
- What is my co-pay or co-insurance once the deductible is met?
- How many visits are allowed per calendar year?
- Do any outpatient behavioral/mental health services require prior authorization?
- What is the effective date of my coverage?

As courtesy to our clients, our billing department will file claims to your primary insurance provider. We do not file secondary insurance.

**Out of Network:**

If your insurance coverage is through a company not listed above, including **Medicaid (Caresource)**, you may have out-of-network behavioral/mental health benefits which might provide some reimbursement. If you have no coverage, you (or your child) may still be a client at AFC, by choosing to pay for services out of pocket.

**COUNTY FUNDING:** We are contracted with and accept funding from the following:

If you wish to use county funding for services, please be sure to provide the caseworker's name and telephone number on the intake form or when talking to our Intake Coordinator.

**FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY:**

If you choose to file with your insurance, we ask that you pay your co-payment or required percentage at the time of each session. We suggest that you keep track of such things as your deductible, any required pre-certifications and/or the number of authorized sessions.
